	Children can name the city in which they live and place it within the country and world.	Children describe their own immediate environment using knowledge from observation, discussion, stories, non-fiction texts and maps.

	Extend children's vocabulary, explaining unfamiliar words and concepts and making sure children have understood what they mean through stories and other activities.	Making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems.
L PSED PD	To take pride in their writing.	
	Children write letters that convey meaning to them. Eg. Their name.	Children produce a piece of writing for a purpose. Eg. A letter, postcard or list.
PSED PD	To show a commitment in learning a new skill.	
	Children can ride a balance bike with confidence.	Children can ride a two wheeled pedal bike.
PSED C&L L	To perform songs, poems and rhymes with confidence	
	Children perform nursery rhymes with confidence.	Children perform our 'Rhyme of the week' and Talk4Writing stories with confidence.
PSED UW EAD L C&L	To recognise and be respectful of multiple perspectives	
	Children share experiences and explore the concepts of fairness, tolerance and forgiveness through small group activities and everyday play such as role play, small world and storytelling.
